- The awardee is expected to bear the cost of meeting registration.
- There will be no financial liability of the IPS.
- All the contestant/recipients should be the member of the Society during the year of presentation.
- The contestants will have to give a brief biodata, the certificate furnishing the age proof and proof of pursuing Ph.D. (First to Third year only) and one page a short paragraph, stating how participation in the APS meeting will lead toward achievement of their professional goals.

About Tripura

Tripura is one of the smallest states in the country, with a total geographic area of about 10,491 sq. km. It has diverse range of topography, people, flora and fauna. The state is a landlocked and hilly with altitudes varying from 15 to 940 meters above sea level, though majority of the population live in the plains. It is situated between latitudes 22°56' and 24°32' North, and longitudes 90°09' and 92°20' East with tropic of cancer passing through it.

About the Venue

The College of Agriculture, Tripura is located at Lembucherra, West Tripura district. The college is situated in the vicinity of the College of Fisheries, Central Agriculture University; Indian Council of Agriculture Research (ICAR) Complex for the North Eastern Hill Region (Tripura Centre) and Holycross College, Jubatara. The abstracts should contain a title, names of authors, their affiliation and a brief summary of results (**not exceeding 250 words**). All Abstracts should be submitted latest by **14th January, 2019**. Abstracts should be submitted with Registration Form in Electronic Form only as email attachment to ipnezone2018@gmail.com.

Oral Presentation

Participants are requested to bring the power point presentation. A 15 min oral presentation will be provided to senior scientists and 5 min to young scientist/ students.

Posters Preparation

The poster should be of standard size of 80 cm x 100 cm (width x height) showing title, authors, address, e-mail of presenting author, introduction, materials and methods, results and conclusion in brief.
